2010 KUMQUATICITRUS QUILT CHALLENGE RULES

All items must reflect the theme **"It's All About Orange"**. Creative and prominent use of orange is required! Orange represents the color of the Kumquat! Of course, you can incorporate other colors (greens, yellows, etc.) and material with fruit (oranges, limes, lemons, and of course, kumquats) if you desire. Be creative and have fun!

Quilts (quilted and bound items including quilts, wall hangings, table runners or toppers):

1. Perimeter no more than 250".
2. May be made by individuals or groups.
3. Both machine and hand quilting are acceptable.
4. Each item must have a 4" wide sleeve attached for hanging.

Clothing:

1. Any item of clothing is acceptable.
2. No mass produced items. Hanger for clothing should be provided

Miniature Quilts:

1. Maximum size: 12" per side
2. All techniques: quilts with overall patterns reflecting reduced scale: If using block construction, the blocks should measure no larger than 4"

Miscellaneous: purses, totes, dolls, pillows, placemats, etc.

1. Must be able to be displayed, i.e., posable doll or provide a stand.

All items must have a label with name, address, and phone number on the back or inside. (However, the names will be covered up with painters tape during the official judging.)

Judging: Judges (local residents and business owners in the sewing field) will award 1st, 2nd, and 3rd place winners in each of the above four categories. Judges decisions are final. Challenge judging will be held on January 28, 2010. The place and time is to be determined. In addition, Viewers Choice 1st, 2nd, and 3rd place winners will be voted on at the Kumquat Festival January, 30, 2010 and given to the exhibitors who have received the most votes from the visitors at the Kumquat Festival who voted for their favorite in each of the above categories.

All items must be turned in to the Greater Dade City Chamber of Commerce office 8am to 5pm beginning January 18 and no later than 5pm on January 22, 2010 in order to be considered for this year's challenge. Any items that need to be mailed or shipped to the Quilt Challenge are the responsibility of the contestant; that includes insurance against loss or theft.
